RE: SEPTEMBER 25, 2025 POSTAL DISRUPTION

On September 25, 2025, without prior notice, the Canadian Union of Postal Workers announced postal disruptions.

A postal disruption does not suspend or extend any deadlines for submissions to Legal Registries. As a result of a disruptions, clients should consider how it could affect doing business at Legal Registries.

Documents to Legal Registries

Submitting documents to the Securities Office or the Personal Property Registry which only accept electronic submissions will continue unaffected. However, submissions to Land Titles Office and Corporate Registries will need to be via courier or be delivered in-person.

Documents from Legal Registries

The Personal Property Registry will send Notices to Secured Parties by courier at the Registry's expense, effective immediately.

All other documents will no longer be sent from Legal Registries pending the resumption of postal operations. These documents will be available for pick up at Legal Registries, by courier, or will be sent by regular mail depending on the circumstances and progress of negotiations.
