ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Pursuant to section 41(4)(a) of the *Residential Tenancies Act*, the respondent shall pay the applicant rent arrears in the amount of two thousand four hundred sixty four dollars (\$2464.00)
2. Pursuant to section 84(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act*, the respondent may pay the rent arrears in monthly installments of no less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), the first payment becoming due on March 1, 2003 and payable thereafter on the first day of every month until this order is fully satisfied.

3. Pursuant to section 41(4)(b) of the *Residential Tenancies Act*, the respondent shall pay all future rent on time.

REASONS FOR DECISION

REASONS FOR DECISION

The respondent was served with a Notice of Attendance on February 12, 2003 but failed to appear at the hearing. The hearing was held in her absence.

The applicant alleged that the respondent had breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay rent and sought an order requiring the respondent to pay the alleged rent arrears in reasonable monthly installments. The applicant provided a copy of the tenant ledger which indicated a balance of rent owing in the amount of \$2464.

I find the respondent breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay the lawful rent to the landlord. I find the rent arrears to be \$2464. An order shall be issued requiring the respondent to pay the applicant the rent arrears in monthly installments of no less than \$100 along with the monthly assessed rent. The first payment shall be due on March 1, 2003 and thereafter on the first day of every month until the rent arrears are paid in full. The order shall also require the respondent to pay the monthly assessed rent on time.

Should the respondent fail to pay the rent arrears in accordance with this order or fail to pay the monthly rent on time, the applicant may file a future application requesting the rental officer to rescind this order and order the lump sum payment of the remaining rent arrears and/or termination of the tenancy agreement.
