## REASONS FOR DECISION

The applicant alleged that the respondent had breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay rent and sought an order requiring the respondent to pay the alleged rent arrears.

The applicant provided a copy of the tenant ledger in evidence which indicated a balance of rent owing in the amount of $\$ 1904.40$. A previous order required the respondent to pay rent arrears and to pay future rent on time. The previous order has been satisfied.

The respondent did not dispute the allegations.

I find the ledger in order and find the respondent in breach of her obligation to pay rent. I find the rent arrears to be $\$ 1904.40$. An order shall issue requiring the respondent to pay the applicant rent arrears in the amount of $\$ 1904.40$. A previous order was issued requiring the respondent to pay future rent on time.
