## REASONS FOR DECISION

The premises are a mobile home lot. The applicant alleged that the respondent had failed to pay any rent from May, 2004 to present. The rent for the premises is $\$ 250 /$ month. The applicant testified that he had given a rent credit of $\$ 1000$ for work performed by the respondent's former partner bringing the balance owing to $\$ 4000$. The applicant sought an order requiring the respondent to pay the alleged rent arrears.

The respondent did not dispute the allegations. She stated that she had been away at school and believed her former partner who remained in the unit, would pay the monthly rent.

I find the respondent in breach of her obligation to pay rent and find the rent arrears to be $\$ 4000$. An order shall issue requiring the respondent to pay the applicant rent arrears in the amount of $\$ 4000$.
