IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Pursuant to section 41(4)(a) of the *Residential Tenancies Act*, the respondents shall pay the applicant rent arrears in the amount of one thousand two hundred fifteen dollars (\$1215.00).
2. Pursuant to sections 41(4)(c) and 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act*, the tenancy agreement between the parties for the premises known as Apartment 412, 42 Con Road, Yellowknife, NT shall be terminated on March 31, 2003 and the respondents shall vacate the premises on that date, unless the rent arrears are paid in full.

REASONS FOR DECISION

The respondents were served with Notices of Attendance on February 27, 2003 but failed to appear at the hearing. The hearing was held in their absence.

The applicant alleged that the respondents had breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay rent and sought an order requiring the respondents to pay the alleged rent arrears and terminating the tenancy agreement unless the arrears were paid by March 31, 2003. The applicant provided a statement of the rent which indicated a balance of rent owing in the amount of \$1215.

I find the statement of rent in order. I find the respondents breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay the lawful rent to the landlord. I find the rent arrears to be \$1215. In my opinion, there are sufficient grounds to terminate the tenancy agreement unless the rent arrears are promptly paid.

An order shall be issued requiring the respondents to pay the applicant rent arrears in the amount of \$1215 and terminating the tenancy agreement between the parties on March 31, 2003 unless the rent arrears are paid in full.
