REASONS FOR DECISION

The applicant alleged that the respondents breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay the full amount of the rent and sought an order requiring the respondents to pay the alleged rent arrears.

The applicant provided a copy of the tenant ledger in evidence which indicated a balance of rent as at March 31, 2003 in the amount of \$7435.59. The applicant testified that since that date the following transactions had occurred, bringing the balance owing to \$8255.59.

Balance owing	\$8255.59

I find the respondents breached their obligation to pay rent and find the balance of rent arrears to be \$8255.59. An order shall be issued requiring the respondents to pay the applicant rent arrears in the amount of \$8255.59.
