**REASONS FOR DECISION**

The applicant stated that since the application was made, the respondent had paid all of the outstanding rent and currently had a credit balance. The applicant sought an order requiring the respondent to pay future rent on time.

The respondent did not dispute the allegation of late payment of rent.

A copy of the tenant ledger was presented in evidence. The written tenancy agreement between the parties requires payment of rent in advance on the first day of each month. The ledger indicates that the rent had not always been paid on the days it was due.

I find the respondent breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay the rent on the days it was due. An order shall issue requiring the respondent to pay future rent on time.
