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**REASONS FOR DECISION** 

The applicant alleged that the respondent had breached the tenancy agreement by failing to pay

for electricity during the term of the agreement. The premises are subsidized public housing.

The applicant provided a copy of the tenancy agreement in evidence. Article 8 of the agreement

obligates the tenant to pay for electricity. The applicant testified that the electricity was

disconnected on May 5, 2011 for non-payment but has since been reconnected. The applicant

sought an order requiring the respondent to comply with her obligation to pay for electricity and

to not breach that obligation again.

The respondent did not dispute the allegation.

I find that the respondent breached her obligation to pay for electricity. An order shall issue

requiring the respondent to comply with her obligation to pay for electricity and to not breach

that obligation again.
